Trains to Leicester

Leicester is very well served by trains from all over the country. View timetable and book tickets at either www.thetrainline.com or <http://www.eastmidlandstrains.co.uk/emtrains>

Be aware that standard open tickets from (or through) London are very expensive during peak hours, so please check the timetable carefully when you buy (or book in advance) your tickets.

From Leicester Train Station to the Conference

Taxis

Black cabs are available outside the station. Alternatively there is a taxi office over the road who may be slightly cheaper (ABC Taxis 0116 255 5111). Please ensure that you ask to be taken to the 'halls of residence' and NOT the 'University of Leicester'. Cost approx. £8

Bus

The Arriva Bus service runs to Oadby, bus stops are outside the train station: 80/80A is less frequent during University Holidays and stops outside Beaumont Hall - Please see timetable for details.

29/31 destined for Oadby Grange. When on the bus, stand up when you reach the large roundabout at the racecourse. When leaving the bus turn left to the end of the road and then turn right, you are now on Stoughton Drive South.
